**Please Note: No driving vehicles or golf carts on grass anywhere on the premises except for those used by Festival workers.**

**Professional Standards:** All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner. Breakdown may begin at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, not before.

**Pets:** The Leaf Festival is held in a pet friendly area. Many attendees bring pets to the event. Therefore, due to liability issues, participants may not bring pets.

**Smoking:** As a courtesy to fellow Artists/Merchants and festival attendees, please do not smoke or use tobacco products in or around tents.

**Cleanup:** Please cleanup around your area after teardown and before leaving to make sure all garbage is put in nearby containers.

**Sales Tax:** All artists are responsible to collect and submit payment to the North Carolina Department of Revenue. North Carolina and Jackson County combined tax is currently 7%.

**Booth Standards:** White Tents only must be used by all participants. No other colors are permitted. Festival information tents and food tents may use approved colors. Tents must be staked and secured in a safe manner for a grass surface. Please **invest in a durable, sturdy tent with wind vents**. While lightweight pop-up tents may seem like an economical arrangement, we have seen these kinds of tents blow over, bend, twist, collapse, and rip with only minimal wind gusts. When set up in close quarters with your fellow artists, a tent that blows over can have devastating effects on neighboring tents, even if their tent is otherwise sturdy and secure. Wind vents are crucial because they allow wind to blow through your tent rather than blowing it away. Decorating with a fall theme is encouraged. The layout allows for ample room behind tents for storage of additional product and other items. These items should be kept neat and orderly. No generators are allowed.

**Booth Fee:** \$325.00 per 10 x 10 space. Add \$75.00 for Electricity. Electricity is limited in quantity and location. Your checks will be deposited after the jury has accepted your application. If your application is declined, the checks will be returned.

**Application:** Please provide completed application and photos as listed above (digital images preferred). Artists will receive a notice of acceptance or declination within three weeks of receipt of the complete application and payment. The Final Application deadline is August 30th, 2019. Applications received and accepted after this date, will be assessed a \$25.00 late fee.

**Cancellation Policy:** In the event a participant must cancel after August 15th, 2019, no refunds will be given. This is a *Rain or Shine* event
